



## Photographers/Media Briefing Sheet

### Preamble:

For all Canterbury Off Road Club Incorporated permitted Events the Clerk of the Course is held responsible for the safety of all persons admitted to the Event.

The Clerk of the Course seeks your cooperation in assisting so that the Event can run safely and without any increased risk.

As a consequence you are requested to consider the following points closely and should you have any concerns then these should be raised with the Canterbury Off Road Club Incorporated appointed Media representative or if not present the Clerk of the Course prior to signing of the Consent & Indemnity declaration.

### Conditions of permission consent to receive photographers privileges

1. A compulsory media briefing will be given before each event. Appropriate safety equipment will be issued before proceeding onto the track area which may include a hi-vis vest, radio, fire extinguisher and in some instances a vehicle for access to the track.

1. For endurance races, a map of the track will be given out at the media briefing outlining the areas of permitted access and in some cases the special conditions that are in force at these access areas. It is imperative that you are not in any of the no go areas during any on track activity.

2. During track activities you are allowed to move to another of the permitted access areas however it is highly recommended that you do not cross the active track line. If you choose to cross the track line during a race you understand that this at your own risk. Your safety is paramount at all times. If you cross through a no go area ensure that there is sufficient time to complete the move before on track activities occur.

3. At all times you must obey the requirements of the marshals and/or the clerk of the course.

4. On arrival at your chosen area please ensure you position yourself in a safe zone however make certain you remain clearly visible to competitors on the track at all times.

5. At the conclusion of the event report back in with your media representative.
