Drivers and passengers to sign in, complete all paperwork, have race gear checked and have arm bands put on

Once paperwork and gear check is complete join queue for race vehicle check

If you are not in the queue by 9.00am you will start at the back of your class for all heats

Scrutineering will be as per the ORANZ rulebook. Arm restraints or window nets are strongly recommended. Front window meshes are also strongly recommended as there are stones present on the track surface.
